Chandler has a BA in History from Texas A&M and a MA in History from the University of Alabama.

Chandler has worked at the Institute of Texas Cultures and the George H.W. Bush Presidential Library. Chandler currently works as an educator for the Texas Historical Commission. As an educator for the THC, he has been responsible for implementing educational programs across the state, including the Fulton Mansion, Barrington Farms and at the Fanthorp Inn. Chandler recently participated as the Keynote Speaker in a Graveside Ceremony for Col. Kenneth Lewis Anderson, the last Vice President of the Republic of Texas. The ceremony was held at the Fanthorp Family Cemetery on July 20, 2024.
